About the Christian R. and Mary F. Lindback Foundation and The School District of Philadelphia's Lindback Award for Distinguished Teaching

Countless Philadelphians of a certain age remember waking up to a distinctive sound--the pleasing clink of glass bottles against a metal carrier meant that the Abbotts milkman was at the door.

Now, thanks to the vision and generosity of the late Christian R. Lindback, the president and principal owner of Abbotts, and his wife, Mary F. Lindback, excellence in education is celebrated through the foundation that bears their names.

Since 1961, the foundation has been recognizing outstanding faculty members at colleges and universities in Pennsylvania and New jersey with the Lindback Award for Distinguished Teaching. Currently 52 institutions of higher learning are participating in the program with each honoree receiving a \$4,000 stipend.

The School District of Philadelphia's Lindback Award for Distinguished Teaching is being presented for the sixth time to School District educators. Established in 2008, this award is bestowed annually to an exemplary teacher in each of the School District's high schools. Each one of the fifty-nine recipients received \$3,500 from the foundation.

Further recognizing professionalism in our schools, last month the foundation presented the newly established Lindback Award for Distinguished Principal Leadership to seven School District of Philadelphia principals. Each received a \$15,000 stipend to be used to benefit the school.

The School District is the only K-12 educational organization whose staff has been singled out by the foundation trustees for this recognition.
